

# Poppy Pattern

## Materials

West Yorkshire Spinners DK red and black wool  
2.5mm Crochet Hook  
Felt  
Badge Back  
Optional Button

## Abbreviations (UK)

ch chain  
dc double crochet  
dc2tog double crochet 2 stitches together  
htr half treble  
tr treble crochet  
st(s) stitch(es)  
ch sp chain space

## Finished measurement

Flower diameter 8 cm

## Tension

Tension is not critical on this project

## Method

Either make 4 separate petals or make a foundation ring of 12 ch sts and join with a ss. Crochet petals onto this foundation ring (petals 3 and 4 are made partially on top of other two petals).

## Individual Petals

Foundation chain of 4ch sts

Row 1 dc in each ch st, turn (4 sts)

Row 2 1 ch, 2 dc in each dc st, turn (8 sts)

Row 3 1 ch, dc in first dc st, htr in following 6 dc sts, dc in last st, turn

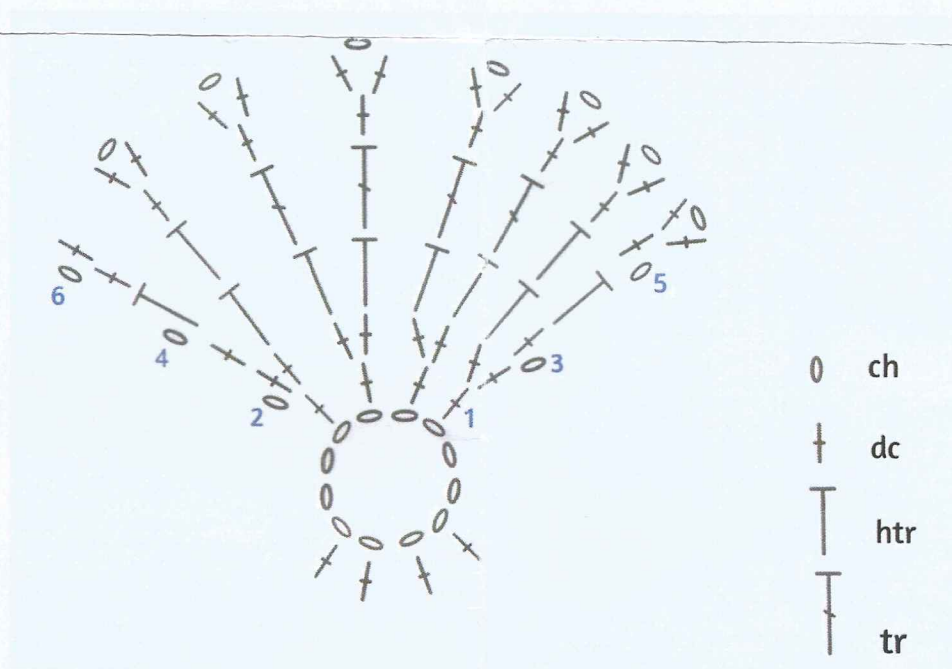
Row 4 1 ch, htr in first 2 sts, tr in following 4 sts, htr in last 2 sts, turn

Row 5 1 ch, dc in each sts, turn

Row 6 1 ch, dc in first st, (dc, ch, dc) in following 6 sts, dc in last st. Break yarn

Sew together and sew in ends.

If you are making a foundation ring, you do not need to make the 4 ch sts at the beginning, simply dc directly into the sts in the foundation ring.



## Poppy middles

Either sew on a black button into the middle or crochet with black yarn the following pattern:

Round 1 Ch2, 6 dc into 2<sup>nd</sup> ch from hook (6 sts)

Round 2 2dc in each dc st (12 sts)

Round 3 dc in each st (12 sts)

Round 4 dc2tog six times (6 sts), cast off leaving a long tail to thread onto a wool needle.

## Sew into middle of poppy.

To make a brooch, sew brooch back onto felt and then sew felt onto the back of your poppy
